

Evacuation of jobless from Mozambique's towns (ME/7365/B/4: excerpts) High-ranking party and state leaders yesterday met with residents of several residential areas of the capital to explain to them the process of the evacuation of unproductive people from the towns, which began on a voluntary phase basis yesterday. At the Mavalane residential area, Armando Guebuza, the Minister of the Interior, addressing thousands of people, said that all the provinces were prepared to receive the jobless. . .
