Food aid for Mozambique

MAPUTO. — The largest pledges of food aid for Mozambique for the year May 1986 to April 1987 have so far come from the European Economic Community, according to figures in a report published this week by the food security department of the Ministry of Trade.

The EEC has pledged a total of 55 000 tonnes of grain. Other major pledges have come from the World Food Programme (44 000 tonnes), Canada (20 000 tonnes), the United States (17000 tonnes), India (15000)(14 000 tonnes), Italy and Britain tonnes) (14 000 tonnes).
