A statement from the commission said the aid package would be implemented by European nongovernmental organisations based in Mozambique and Zimbabwe Freedown From Hugger

dom From Hunger. Goods worth \$1 620 000

would be bought in Zimbabwe and transported to Mozambique for distribution to displaced persons. These are beans, sugar, groundnuts, milk powder, soup powder, blankets, kitchen utensils, cutlery, hoes and medicine.

The EEC financed similar programmes through the ZFFH in 1984 and 1985. It has also given about \$17 000 worth of white maize to Mozambique bought from Zimbabwe in the last 12 months.
