Mozambique: increased aid from EC The EC has increased by more than 15m ECUs (European Currency Units - about 18m US dollars) its aid to Mozambique within the context of the economic rehabilitation programme, Maputo radio reported on 19th April (citing the Mozambican agency). This is in addition to the 130m ECUs granted by the EC within the framework of the Lome convention, which Mozambique joined in 1984. The latter funding has been used in fishing projects, the rehabilitation of the Beira corridor, and support for the sectorial imports programme.
