Ex-governor to visit Mozambique

LISBON.—A former Governor-General of Mozambique, now newly-appointed Overseas Minister, Dr Rebello de Souza (52), is to tour Angola and Mozambique next month.

A genial, bespectacled surgeon, Dr de Souza is expected to spend two to three weeks in southern Africa on a see-for-himself trip to get first-hand knowledge of the newly-dubbed "states," particularly in relation to their economy, and learn the effect of the autonomy authorised by Lisbon a year ago.

Dr de Souza was Governor-General of Mozambique from 1968 to 1970 during which time he paid official visits to Malawi and Swaziland.

Author of several books on overseas administration and social and cultural matters, he was appointed Minister of Social Welfare in January, 1970.
