

**Mozambique Defence Minister's visit to Portugal** Maputo radio reported Lt-Gen Alberto Chipande as saying on 30th October that Mozambique might import Portuguese-made lorries for the army to use in fire fighting. On 1st November the Minister, at a fraternity meeting attended by Mozambican and Portuguese soldiers, had referred to the unjust war which had been imposed on Mozambique. In reply, the Portuguese COS, General Melo Egidio, had said: You can count on the greatest sincerity and co-operation from the Portuguese armed forces. '82
