

Military training centre in Mozambique designed by Portuguese officers (Text) Three Portuguese military officers who have been in Mozambique for the past three months are now nearing the end of their visit, during which they worked with Mozambican authorities in designing a military training centre. The officers, two of them engineers and one a military architect, have completed the design and work on the project is expected to start as soon as it is approved by the Mozambican Government. The leader of the delegation said that their stay in Mozambique has been successful and interesting. The delegation will leave Maputo for Portugal on Tuesday [28th June].
