Mozambique: Portuguese report says government hindering aid distribution (*Text*) In Mozambique, new demands by Maputo are interrupting humanitarian aid distribution, an official told the Lusa [Portuguese] news agency today. In addition to banning the circulation of lorries of over 38 t, the Mozambican government has imposed a six-fold rise in tolls. This measure increases by 35% the overall rail transport costs of emergency food supplies along the Beira corridor. (*Radiodifusao Portuguesa, Lisbon 1900 gmt 12 Oct 92*)
